PART 3: ORGANIZING YOUR RESEARCH AND FINDING IMAGES

STEP 1: Organizing your research

- *It's time to turn your research into complete sentences that answer your question completely. You should have between 4 and 6 sentences per answer.
 - *Your goal is to write each answer in an organized fluid way so the reader can easily understand the facts you are presenting them with.
 - *You should not have to read the question first. The first sentence of your answer should be your question turned into a statement.
 - *At the end of each answer you need to cite your source. Write down the website you found the information.

STEP 2:

*Transfer your writing from notability into a google document in your social studies folder.

STEP 3:

- *It's time to organize and find your images using explain everything or voicethread (you will be recording your answers as you go through your slide show).
 - *You are required to have a title slide, 2 slides per answer and a resource slide. This is a total of 12 slides!
 - * Your images must support and help explain your answers as you read them. For example: if your answer includes facts about the Ganges river pollution you should have an image of the polluted Ganges River on your slideshow to go along with it.

STEP 4:

- *Turn in your project via email or in your social studies folder.
 - *I need the presentation and the written answers to your questions in order for you to receive credit for the full project
